



City of Park Ridge Survey Results - 2008

In a recent survey conducted by the National Research Center, Inc. for the City of Park Ridge, the Park Ridge Recreation and Park District came out ahead of the competition. Specific to Parks and Recreation, our constituents rated the Park District above the norm in 'Quality of Leisure Services'. In the 'Quality of Life' section, results demonstrated that raising children in Park Ridge received a rating of 81 on a 100-point scale. Children are Park Ridge Park District's largest population served. The survey results indicated Park Ridge residents rate the Park District above the norm.
